

OREGON OBSIDIAN SOURCES

DANT

ALTERNATE NAMES: Deschutes Canyon Obsidian and Perlite.

LOCATION - COUNTY: Wasco.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE: Negligible. While the quality of the glass is good, available nodules are generally small and only a single obsidian artifact has been correlated with this source.
